5-G or Multi-G

5-G or Multi-G: 5G is more than just a fast 4G. Network core provides the critical services and features providing the expected added value of 5G. The mobile core is the multi-service hub for mobile networks, supporting 2G, 3G, 4G and 5G services. Multi-G support drives support 2G, 3G, 4G and 5G services, instead of 4G and 5G integration.

The Hyperscale Revolution

The Hyperscale Revolution: Large and expandable data centers are used to enable businesses to rapidly enter new markets, by building hyperscale data centers. How does it happen? What technologies are employed? What conditions to attract hyperscalers?





Robotics & Drones

Robotics & Drones: Mechanical devices automated or remote controlled for manufacturing, for surgery or semiconductor production and unmanned vehicles.

AR & VR

AR & VR: Hardware and software that create content and distribute AR-related products. VR software and hardware that immerse users in a three-dimensional, virtual world. Wearable devices, environments where users can interact through avatars are target here.

Toll & Tol

IoT & IIoT: Industrial Internet of Things (IIoT) is expected to transform industries and open new markets. However, IoT adoption faces the challenge of simplifying complexities. The lack of standards in interfaces, protocols and architectures is slowing down IoT applications implementation.

Cloud-Tech & DevOps

Cloud-Tech & DevOps: How do organizations develop, operationalize and monitor software and applications at scale. Hybrid cloud computing and the need for digital intellectual property is driving demand for tools and services to improve software development and operation capabilities.

Zero-Trust Architecture & Cybersecurity

Zero-Trust Architecture & Cybersecurity: Vendors are moving towards built-in security models. Automated verification is a key tenet of zero trust models enabling built-in security, while encryption is increasingly important to ensure systems are capable of maintaining data confidentiality, where data and executables are protected at all points.

Agri-Tech




Space-Tech

Retail-Tech

Retail-Tech: Products and services to improve consumer experiences. It targets, hypermarkets and retailers at large. It also covers the entire supply chain from factory to consumer. Also, restaurant customer-based technologies help owners increase profitability, efficiency and customer engagement, acquisition and retention.

Ad-Tech

Ad-Tech: Advertising technology including software and services that deliver, control and target online advertising, create targeted advertisements based on user interest and behavior.

Entertain-Tech

Entertain-Tech: This is not only about changing user consumption, but is also about creating new channels and devices to engage with content. Also, gaming is bigger than ever, where 2021 is another year of disruption for media and entertainment.
